

## Santa Fe County 4-H Scholarships 2013

Scholarships are available to 4-H members currently enrolled in Santa Fe County that attend the following leadership activities. Member must meet the following guidelines to be eligible for a scholarship.

### Scholarship Guidelines:

- Members must complete a written essay on the specified topic. Topics will change each year.
- Essays will be due two weeks prior to the event registration deadline.
- Length of essays will be as follows:
  - Novice: 1-2 pages
  - Junior: 2-4 pages
  - Senior: 3-5 pages
- Essays must be typed in 12 point font. They must be double spaced and have 1 inch margins.
- Essays will be judged and scholarships will be awarded based on points. Essays must score above 70 points to be eligible for a scholarship.

### Judging Criteria:

Appearance and Guidelines- 15 points

- Was the essay neat and easy to read?
- Did the essay meet all the required guidelines?

Structure, Grammar, Spelling- 25 points

Content- 60 points

- Was the topic clearly defined?
- Was the essay easy to understand?
- Did the essay have an introduction, body, and conclusion?
