## **Horse Show**

- 1. The horse show will be help on Sunday July 30, 2023. The show office will open at 8 am and the show will start a the time designated by the Superintendent. The horse show will be held at the Rodeo de Santa Fe arena.
- 2. All livestock in the State of new Mexico fall under the jurisdiction of the New Mexico Livestock Board. Exhibitors must follow all rules in the 2023 Guide for Livestock Exhibitors. This document is available on the New Mexico Livestock Board website.
- 3. In accordance with 77-9-42 NMSA 1978 exhibitors must have horses inspected and have appropriate hauling papers if transporting out of district. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to know if they are transporting out of district to participate in the Santa Fe County Fair Horse show; and to have the correct paperwork in hand. Santa Fe County Fair Board is not responsible for any fines incurred should exhibitor be cited by NMLB for lack of paperwork.
- 4. Santa Fe County Horse Show will follow AQHA rules for classes, requirements, and disqualifications. Including disqualifications for treatment of horses considered inhumane or cruel.
- 5. Entry fee for each class will be determined by Superintendent.
- 6. Classes offered may include, but are not limited to:
  - a. Showmanship
  - b. Hunter Under Saddle
  - c. Hunt Seat Equitation
  - d. English Discipline Rail
  - e. Western Pleasure
  - f. Western Horsemanship
  - g. Trail—This class will have a pattern
  - h. Ranch Horse Riding—This class will have a pattern
  - i. Ranch Horse Reining—This class will have a pattern
  - j. Ranch Horse Riding—This class will have a pattern
  - k. Ranch Horse Trail—This class will have a pattern
