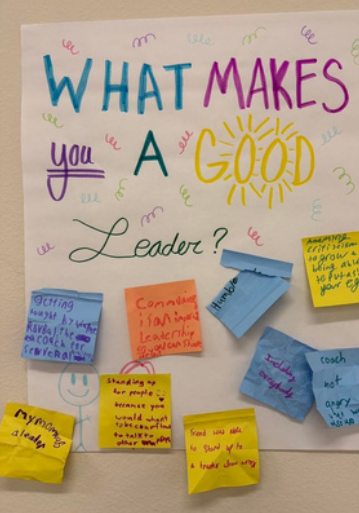
STUDENTS PREP FOR DISTRICT CONTESTS
